





2. Dance Performances: Various dance forms, including classical, folk, and modern dance, were presented by the students.

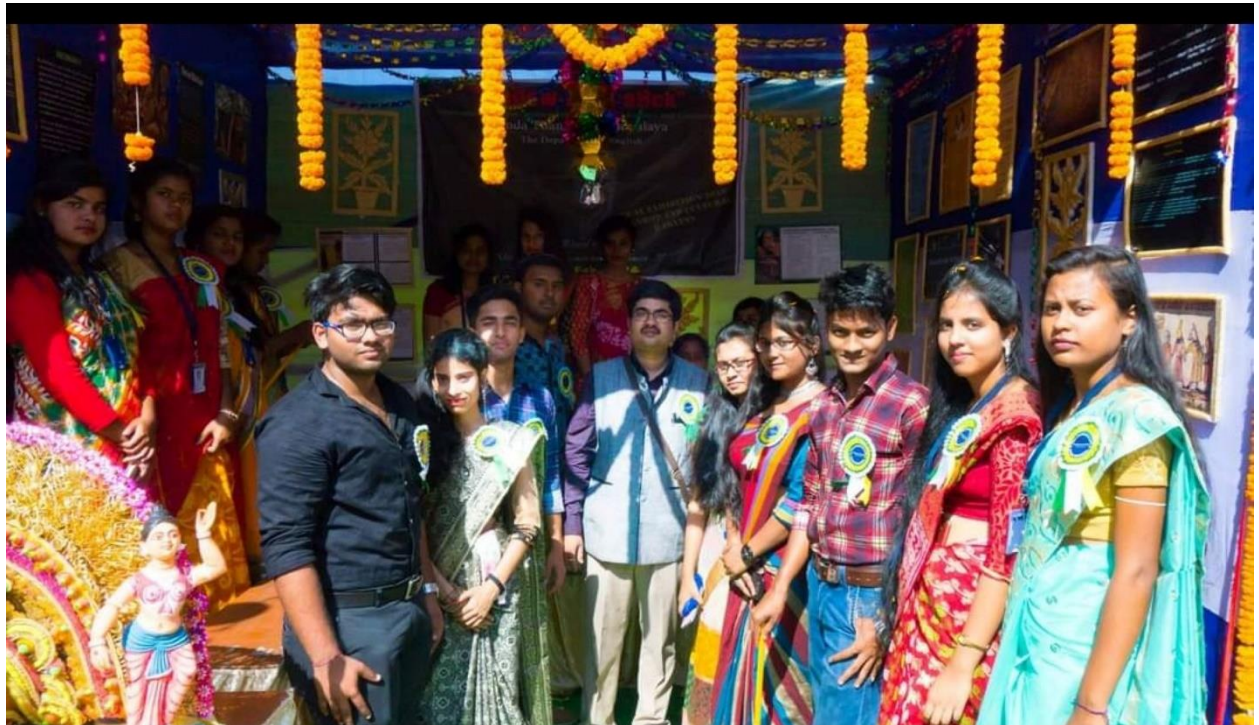
Awards and Recognitions
