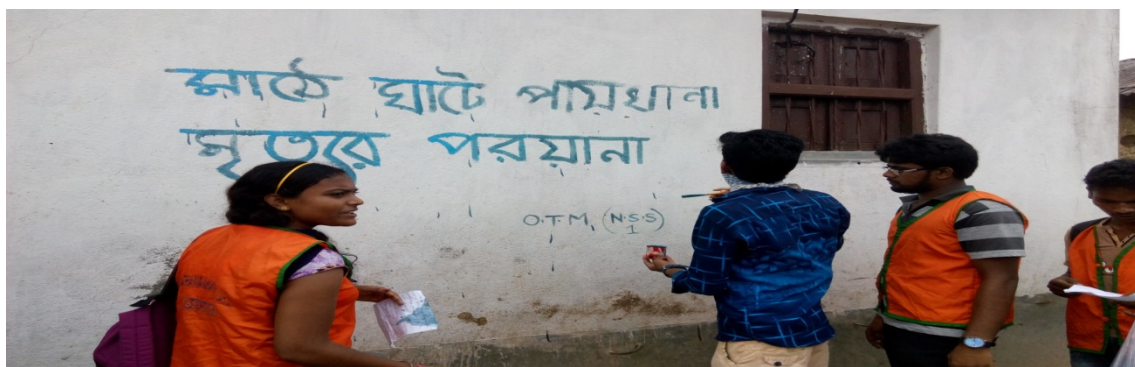

Second day of camp: volunteers cleaned our college premises. Then Dr. Sk Jahir Abbas (programme officer, unit I, NSS) makes Students aware of plastic pollution and alternative thinking of plastic. Dr. Sourav kr Nag (department of English) also delivered a special lecture on "NSS on Praxis".

Third day, a series of lecture delivered by Dr. Santanu Mitra (from Canada), Robin Banerjee, Dr Anupam Pal(Asst. Director, Agricultural Training Centre, Fulia, Nadia). Dr. Mitra discussed on Glyfoset and its effect on animal and human being. Two other Speakers focuses on organic farming. Some farmers from adopted village join in this discussion.

Fourth day, volunteers of unit I went to Dhabani village for survey and volunteers of unit II went to Bheduasole village for survey. In this survey they tried to understand socio- economic conditions of rural people and related problems. Our volunteers made them aware about various problems like school "Drop-out", under age marriage, Dowry system, Effects of smoking on health, plastic pollution, uses of pesticides in agriculture and its effect etc. Farmers of Dhabani village are interested in organic farming. After survey, prof. Driпти Mandal (programme officer, unit II) delivered a lecture on women empowerment.

On the fifth day of the camp, we organised a Blood Donation Camp and an awareness lecture series on HIV and AIDS, Thalassaemia by officers of Health Department (Sadhan Paul, former professor of Bankura Sammilani College; Bipradas Midya, secretary of Bankura Blood Donors` Society; and Dhiman Chakraborty, asst. secretary of Bankura Blood Donors` Society). Our 32 volunteers Spontaneously participated in Blood Donation Camp and donate blood. Programme officers, other teachers and students also donate blood. Same day visitor of university, Mr Jahid Midya came to overlook the camp.

On the sixth day of the camp, Biplab Barat (field reporter) delivered a lecture throwing light on destitution of local heritage. At the same time, he spoke on the necessity of preservation of local

heritage. Dr. Nikhilesh Dhar (Department of English) discussed on indigenous knowledge and tribal culture.

On the seventh day of the camp, our volunteers performed on cultural programme like theatre, recitation, “kathinach”, song, dance, speech etc. we noticed that our volunteers are very energetic, they spontaneously response to this camp.
