

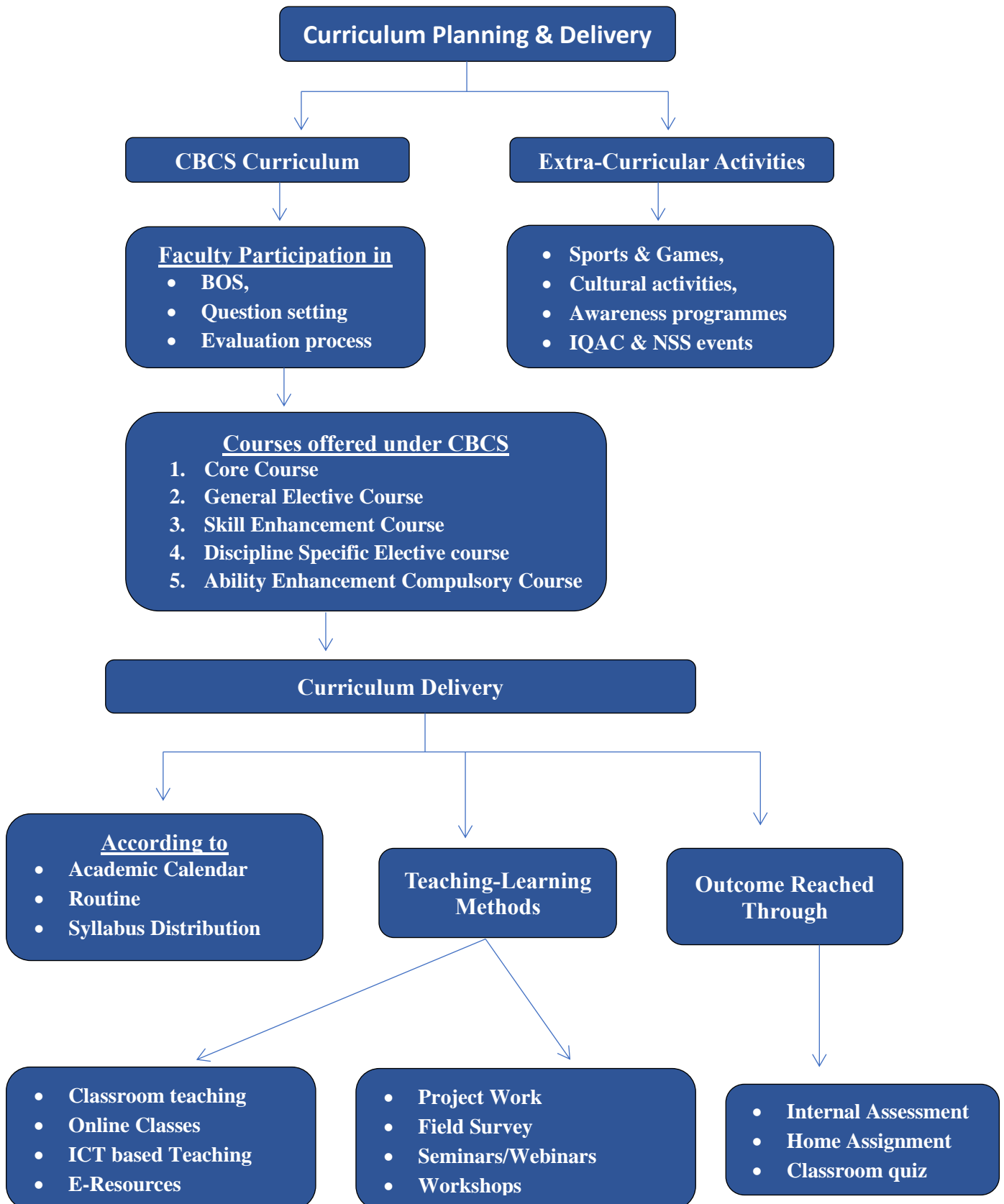

UG Admission for the session 2023-24 with respect to introduction of CCFUP is as follows:

1. Candidate passing Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission in the undergraduate programmes with Single Major and Multidisciplinary Studies under CCFUP within 3 (Three) consecutive academic sessions from the date of passing the qualifying examination.
2. Candidate passing Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) from Vocational stream conducted by the respective Board/ Council for vocational studies or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission in the undergraduate programmes in Multidisciplinary Studies only within 3(Three) consecutive academic sessions from the date of passing the qualifying examination.
3. Candidate must have passed in 5 (Five) recognized subjects (excluding Environmental Studies) including at least one language subject in the qualifying examination.
4. Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in the Aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'Best Five' subjects excluding Environmental Studies) along with pass in the subject/related subject or 50% marks in the subject or related subject are eligible to apply for admission in the Single Major (Hons. /Hons. with Research) programmes.
5. Students carrying pass marks in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination with at least pass in five subjects (excluding Environmental Studies) are eligible to apply for Multidisciplinary programmes under **CCFUP**. Students from Vocational stream are eligible to apply for Multidisciplinary Studies only fulfilling the other criteria.

MERIT POINT

- (i) For Applicants in 4-year Honours course with one Major Subject
Merit Point = 10% of Aggregate + Subject or Highest among the Related Subjects.

(ii) For Applicants in 3-year Multidisciplinary Programme Merit Point = Aggregate.

Approved Council/Board conducting Higher Secondary/Equivalent, henceforth called HS, Examination.

Migrating/Non-migrating and Other Board Students

Students passing from the following Boards/Councils are called Non-migrating students:

- (i) West Bengal Council for Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE),
- (ii) Rabindra Mukto Vidyalaya, West Bengal,
- (iii) West Bengal Board of Madrasah Examination,
- (iv) West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education & Training, Kolkata.

Students passing from any approved Boards/Councils except West Bengal Council for Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) are called Other Board students.

Admission is made strictly in order of merit, and all admissions are provisional. The College authority will not be held responsible for subsequent cancellation of admission due to suppression of facts or false statement made by student at the time of admission. No student under any circumstances, will be admitted after the last date fixed by the University for admission.

A new student must fill up University Registration form within due date and pay registration fee. No candidate will be allowed to sit for the Final Examination of Bankura University if he/ she fail to obtain Registration Certificate.

UG students, willing to apply for half free / full free studentship, must apply in the prescribed form to be provided from the College Office within the due date fixed by the college. The Academic session starts from July of the current year and continues up to June of the subsequent year.

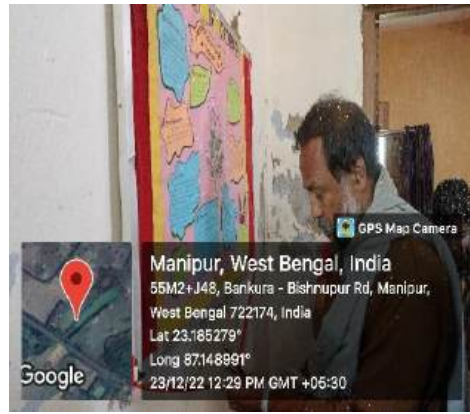


Fig.15: Inauguration of Wall Magazine

সভ্যতার জাত ধরে ক্রমোন্নতির দীর্ঘসিঁড়ি পার হতে হতে সৃষ্টি পরিশীলিত রূপ পেয়েছে সাহিত্য। চারপাশের প্রকৃতি মানুষজন বিচিত্র জীবন- আর তাদের মিশে থাকা প্রাচুর্য সৌন্দর্য ঐশ্বর্য অথবা অপ্রতুলতার অপূর্ণতা - বাপি উজাড় করে সেচন করেছে মনোভূমিকে, অঙ্কুরিত হয়েছে ভাবনা বীজ উপলব্ধি ক্রমশ বিকশিত ... ক্রমশ সমৃদ্ধ ... ক্রমশ পূর্ণ হচ্ছে। “জীবনে জীবন যোগ করার; জীবনকে হৃদয় দিয়ে উপলব্ধি করার পথ বেয়ে আমরা পৌঁছে যাই এক অনির্বচনীয় লোকে। সেই শাস্বত অনির্বচনীয় অনুভূতির অন্বেষণে ব্যাপ্রত “পথিকৃৎ”। এক্ষেত্রে ওন্দা থানা মহাবিদ্যালয়- এর ছাত্র-ছাত্রীদের সদর্থক ও স্বতঃস্ফূর্ত অংশগ্রহন বিশেষভাবে উদ্দীপিত করেছে। নিজেদের ভাবনাকে ছড়ায়, কবিতায়, গল্পে, প্রবন্ধে বা কৌতুক রচনার ছাঁচে টেলে পরিবেশনের চেষ্টা করেছে। কোথাও সফল আবার কোথাও আংশিক সফল। কোনলেখা আবার মনোনয়নের ছাড়পত্র পায়নি। ভালো বই অতি সহজেই আমাদের সঠিক পথ দেখাতে পারে এবং জীবনের পথে এগিয়ে চলার বিষয়ে যথেষ্ট সহযোগিতাও করতে পারে। আমরা সকলে মিলে যদি এই “পথিকৃৎ” কে যদি এইরূপে সদগ্রন্থে পরিণত করতে পারি তাহলে সকলেই তাকে হৃদয়ে ধারণ করে রাখতে পারবে।

শরৎচন্দ্রের কালজয়ী উপন্যাস পল্লীসমাজ -এ রমেশ মে 'আলো' বিকিরণের মাধ্যমে সমাজকে এক নতুন দিশা দেখাতে চেয়েছিলেন, তৎকালীন ২০০৭ সালে বাঁকুড়ার মত একটি প্রান্তিক জেলার বহুমুখী প্রতিভা সম্পন্ন নবীন জন সমাজকে উচ্চশিক্ষার পথ নির্দেশের মহান লক্ষ্যে একরাশ স্বপ্ন নিয়ে বেড়ে ওঠা সদ্য উচ্চমাধ্যমিক উত্তীর্ণ গ্রামবাংলার অগণিত ছাত্র-ছাত্রীকে মহাবিদ্যালয় স্তরে প্রবেশের দিক নির্ণয়ের সুমহান উদ্দেশ্যে স্থাপিত হয়েছিল আমাদের অত্যন্ত প্রিয়, নয়নের মনি ওন্দা থানা মহাবিদ্যালয়। জন্ম কালের সেই চারাগাছ সময়ের গতিবেগে আজ মহীকহে পরিণত হয়েছে। নবকলেবরে, নতুন আঙ্গিকে পশ্চিমবঙ্গের শিক্ষার আঙ্গিনায় বাঁকুড়া বিশ্ববিদ্যালয়ের অন্তর্গত আমাদের মহাবিদ্যালয়টি আজ নিজস্ব গুণে ও স্বমহিমায় উজ্জ্বল ও উদ্ভাসিত।
